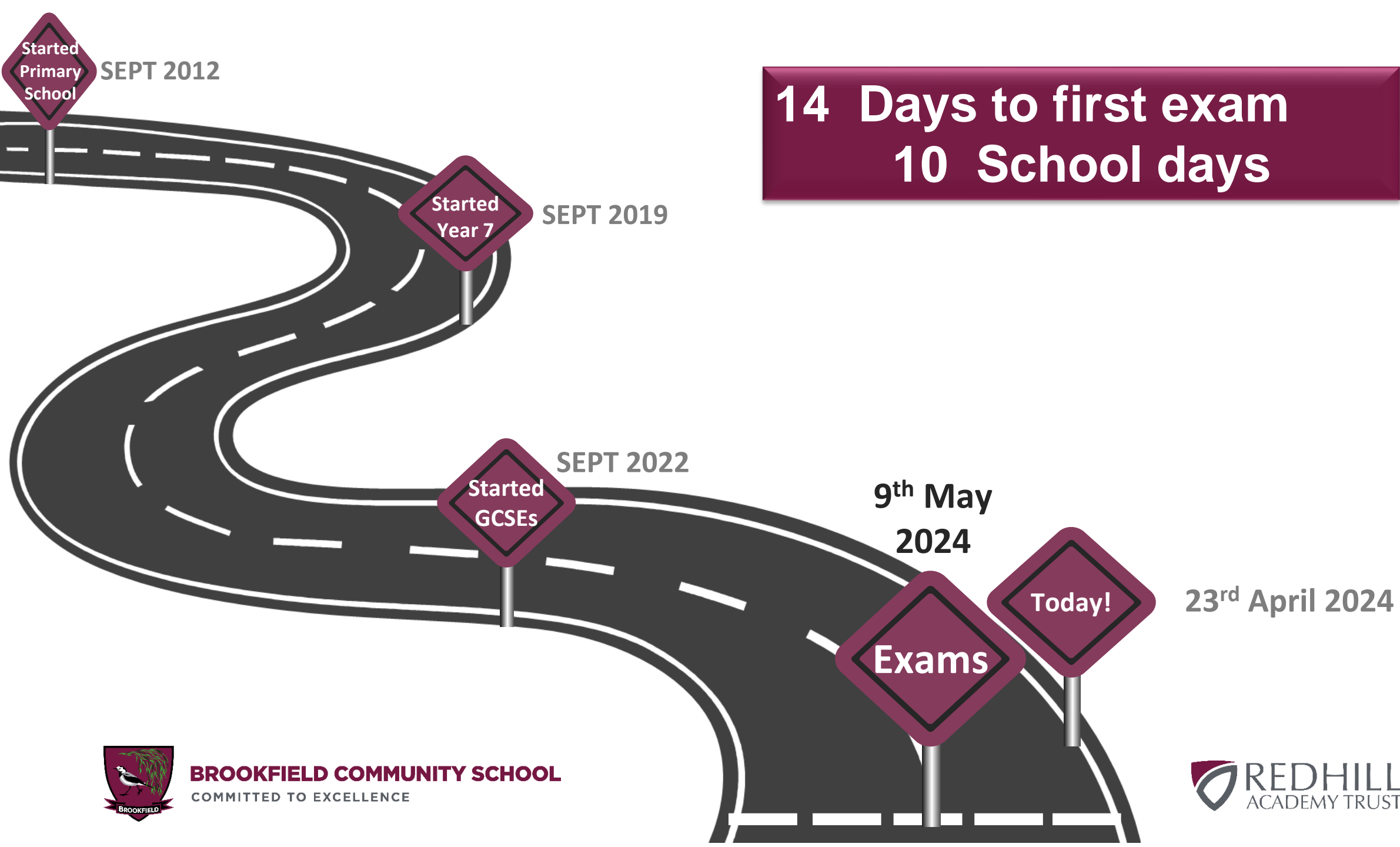

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Warning to Candidates

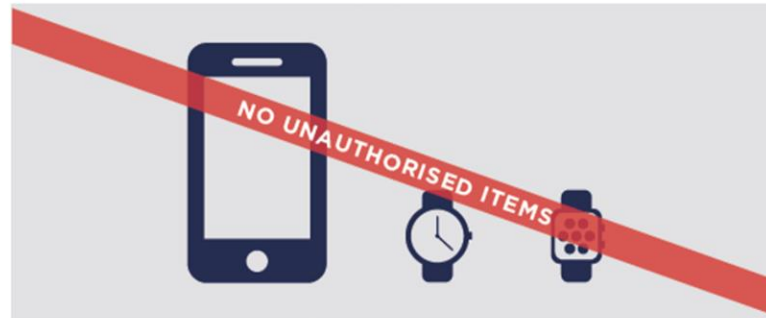

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Did you know?

Students sit the exams at the same time across the country.

You must **not take** any exam stationary out of the exam hall once it has finished.

Exam rules apply to every school throughout the country – checks are made to ensure the rules are followed.

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Social Media

Exam boards monitor social media throughout exam period.

Sharing certain information can break the rules and could affect your results

If you receive exam content on social media, you must tell your teacher

Don't get caught out by scammers selling fake exam paper

Things not to do on social media:

- Buy/ask for/share exam content
- Pass on rumours of what's in exams
- Share your work
- Work with others so that your coursework is not your own independent work



If you do any of the above activities you may:

- Receive a written warning
- Lose marks
- Be disqualified from a part of or all of your qualifications
- Be banned from taking assessments for a number of years

Stay for the full duration

Facing front

No notes in pocket

No contact with anyone

Finish early – check work



If you need anything put your hand up and wait for the invigilator.

Your individual photo card MUST remain visible for the invigilators at all times



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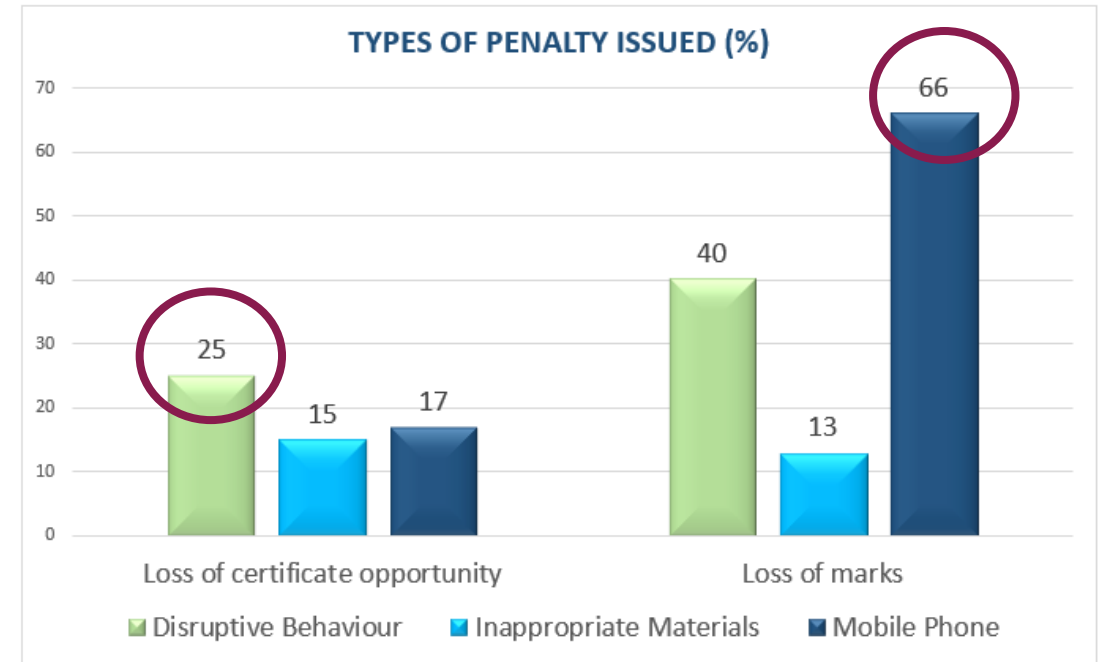
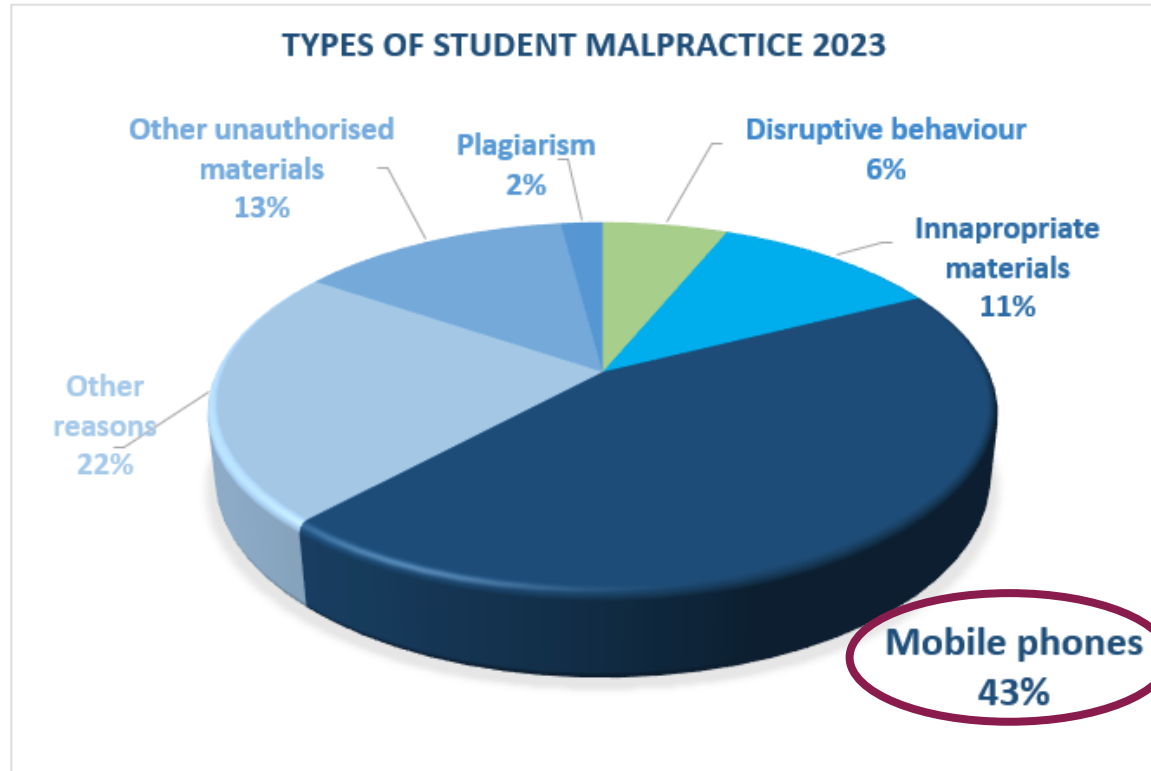
Penalties

Standard Penalties	
1.	Loss of marks gained for a section in an exam
2.	Loss of all the marks gained for a component (part of a course)
3.	Loss of all marks gained for a unit (the exam)
4.	Disqualification from all units in one or more qualifications taken in a series
5.	Disqualification from the qualification
6.	Disqualification from all qualifications taken in that year
7.	Barred from entering examinations for a set period of time

We do not make the decision regarding penalties.
The exam boards do.



There were 4,895 penalties issued to students in the 20232 exams.



43% of these were for a mobile phone or other device in the exam.

25% of students who were disruptive were not awarded their exam.

66% of students who had a mobile phone had marks removed.





Put your pen down and remain in your seat until told otherwise.

If you are informed to move you **MUST** not speak or communicate with anyone!
