## Year 12 Geography Field Visit - Sheffield City Centre, Whitby/East Coast and Linacre

As part of our preparations for the component 4 NEA, an individual investigation based on the collection of both field data and secondary information is to take place. This investigation must be based on a question or issue defined and developed by the individual candidate which is worth 20% of your child's A Level grade. In order to be successful in this examination students will need to collect primary and secondary data.

### Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April – Linacre Reservoir

Students will meet at school at 08.30am and walk with staff to Linacre Reservoir, where we will collect primary data on the hydrological and carbon cycle. Students will need walking shoes/boots, waterproof clothing and a packed lunch. We will walk back to school by 13.50pm and students will then carry out GIS mapping of their results during Period 5.

### Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> April - 08.30 to 3.00pm – Sheffield City Centre

Students should meet teaching staff at Chesterfield Train Station at 08.30am and purchase their own return ticket to Sheffield for the day. Students should be casually dressed and can either bring a packed lunch or purchase items whilst in the city centre. Students will collect primary data associated with sense of place and change over time.

### Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> and Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May- Whitby and East coast residential

Students will travel to Whitby by coach and will spend one night at the Boggle Hole YHA. Students will be provided with an evening meal and breakfast on the second day, and transport throughout the two days. Data will be collected on coastal erosion and honeypot coastal towns. Students will need a packed lunch on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> May and a small amount of money to buy lunch on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May. Students will need to arrive at school by 07.15am on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> May and we expect to arrive back around 7.00pm on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May. Students will need suitable clothing and footwear along with waterproof clothing. The cost of this trip is **£70** and this should be paid via ParentPay by Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2024.
