Committed to Excellence- First Five Expectations

I am writing to you at the end of this first week back after half-term to remind you on the initiative will sharing with students in assemblies next week as we to continue to drive towards excellence in all areas of school.

In the assemblies we will reminding students of the First Five expectations we have during every lesson

1) Students should be on time

The first lesson of the day starts at 8.30 and so the gates on Storrs Road and Chatsworth will be locked at this time. All students should be outside classrooms at 8.25. Those who are late to school will be issued with a C3 detention on the same day. Where students are late for subsequent lessons during the day they will also be given a C3 Late detention.

2) Students should be wearing correct uniform

The full information for uniform can be found [here](#). Students may have only one stud in each ear and any fake nails are not allowed in school. Blazers should be worn at all times when in school unless agreed by a teacher that they can be removed in a lesson. Parents will be contacted if their child arrives to school incorrectly dressed and the child will be asked to return home to change, or their conduct card will be signed for any amendable misdemeanours such as wearing a ring.

3) **All students should have a school bag** containing books, a reading book and the equipment for the day. The student's conduct card will be signed if they do not bring a bag to school.


4) **All students should have a clear pencil case** containing 2 black pens, a green pen, a pencil, a ruler, an eraser and a calculator. **These will be checked every lesson.** The student's conduct card will be signed if they do not have any item of equipment that is needed for the day.

5) Students should not have a mobile phone

We are a mobile phone free site. Any phones brought to school must be switched off and stored in students' bags. They **must not be in blazer or trouser pockets** where they can cause distraction and interfere with learning. If a mobile phone is seen it will be confiscated, kept in a secure place and a C4 detention will be given

Teachers will conduct checks every lesson to ensure students are correctly equipped to learn. Having high expectations for all students is the starting point for success at school and we thank you for your support in ensuring your son/daughter arrives ready to learn.
