YEAR 8 FOOTBALL TEAM REPORT

Following a very successful first season in Y7, Y8 students returned to football practice in September keen to build upon the quality performances of the previous year. With entries into Chesterfield league, the English School Cup and the Derbyshire Cup fixtures have been played every week. Attendance to training has been excellent with over 20 students coming to train each week and build their skills and understanding. We have focused on fast accurate passing to move the ball quickly into space.

The first game of the season was a tough one, drawn against King Ecgberts School from Sheffield in the English Schools Cup, The team were clearly a little rusty having not played together for a while and we lost 4-2, halting any further progress in the competition.

Since then the team have had excellent results against Eckington (5-1), Whittington Green (10-1) and St Marys (8-1). Both A and B teams played against St Marys and it was really pleasing to see the work they had done in training be applied on the pitch. This was the best performance of the year and a convincing win by both teams.

The top scorer for the season so far has been Jacob Reynolds (7) with River Boulton(6) and Bruce Lester Taylor (5) not far behind.

After half term, the team have their first Derbyshire Cup fixture against John Port School. We look forward to progressing within the competition and playing against other schools in Derbyshire.
